



## Academic Performance Index (API) and Accountability Data

The API is a numeric score that measures school and district performance based on a variety of educational indicators. It allows schools and districts to gauge their progress toward improving student achievement. 





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



##### State Results Grade 5 Mathematics






#### Trend Data Grade 5 Reading







##### State Results Grade 8 Mathematics




##### Trend Data Grade 8 Reading






##### State Results Algebra I


##### Trend Data EOI English II
